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HAY BOSS



COST: \$5,000.00 Built
\$4,000 just materials

Material Funded

Group to Build as it comes in a Kit

This Hay Boss is an automatic feeder that allows horses to eat at a leisurely place while grazing in a natural way. It enables the feeder to be put on a fence line to feed two paddocks of horses at once. Rain, snow, mud, wind and waste are no longer an issue with Hay Boss Feeders. It will help at Coat Creek as well when no one is there as we will not have to go back up every day to feed horses. This comes in a kit so we will need someone to put it together.

PHASE 1 COST: \$1,000 posts
\$3,000 Railings

We are looking at redoing the whole paddock area at camp. We have had too many horses get ripped up from the barb wire. We want to enlarge the paddock area as well as create some more smaller paddocks. This will be a 2 –3 phase/ year project so the amount stated is for Phase One which will be the areas closest to the barn and include an outdoor riding arena.

HORSE SHED

COST: \$3,750.00 Built

Sometimes our horses just need to get out of the wind, rain and sometimes the snow. With starting to re-do the corral area, this will be a great addition.

SHED AT THE FAMILY CABIN

Cost: \$3,000 built

There will be someone moving into the Family Cabin as a full time staff member as early as this Spring or Summer. Storage space inside the house is at a premium so we will need something outside to provide them with what they need.

STACKABLE WASHER AND DRYER

COST: \$2,500



Funds

To get our Family Cabin fully operational for the family that will move in there, we need to set up the laundry room up. A stackable will provide us with more space than separate units.

BBQ



COST: \$1,500. each

Our two BBQs have seen better days and need to be replaced. We do a BBQ every Sunday in the month of August and multiple days through the rest of the summer and Fall. We will need 2 BBQs.

WATER SYSTEM FOR THE FAMILY CABIN COST: \$20,000



Material Funded

Someone to do the work.

This is a new system that will handle the needs of the new Family Cabin, our new Washhouse and the main Cook House. We need someone who has the expertise to dig the area and someone to install the cistern and do hookups.

HAY NETS

COST: \$300



Funds

There are many benefits to hay nets including less waste, preventing illness, providing at will and prolonged feeding as well as reducing boredom.

WATERER

COST: \$1,500

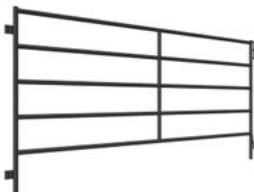

New and more waters are a part of the overhaul of the horse area. More watering stations and cleaner water will help to keep our horses healthy.

Paddock GATES

COST: \$350



Funds

These as well are a part of the overhaul of the horse area providing us with gates to the 4 new paddocks.

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As we continue a major expansion at the camp, there are two projects that need funding that do not require physical labor.

For both of these, the labor will be done by the company that provides the service.

POWER EXPANSION

COST: \$15,000

A bigger transformer is needed to provide the power that will be needed as we build more facilities.



GAS EXPANSION - PART 1

COST:\$7,500

The gas expansion will be in two parts. The first part is to bring in a bigger line to the Director's house and then put in a new line to the new Washhouse/Services Shed.

The second phase will be to do the work ourselves as we take the service to the cabins and the Cookhouse.

MATTRESSES

COST: \$135.00 each



Funds

Back in 2019, we started placing mattresses in each of the cabins. We are almost there in having a mattress on each bunk. We need 10 more to finish this project.

SQUARE BALES

COST: \$14.00 EACH



Funds

We will need 250 bales this year - mostly at Coat Creek but some at Willow Creek as well.

PRAYER DECK FURNITURE

COST: \$1,000



Funds

The furniture on the Prayer Deck is in real need of replacement. The Prayer Deck is such a good place to get away for a bit to pray and to have devotions.

OTHER SMALL PROJECTS THAT WE NEED PEOPLE TO JUST COME AND DO.

THERE IS NO OR LITTLE COST THAT WILL JUST COME OUT OF OUR BUDGET.

- Paint inside of Coat Creek Cook Trailer
- New brakes on the Massey Ferguson tractor
- Fix the hydraulics on the John Deere tractor
- Stairs and railings for the Family Cabin
- Director's house
- Finish Fence at the Director's House—put 10 posts in and put up 10 foot railings
- Put in Hitching rails at the barn
- Build a new hay shed at Coat Creek
- Sand and paint hay wagon
- Mechanical work—brakes, bearings, tie rods, shocks on vehicles
- Build two garbage/recyclable bins
- Sanding, staining and painting
- Eavestrough work
- Rebuild hatchet throwing backstop
- Build horse obstacle course
